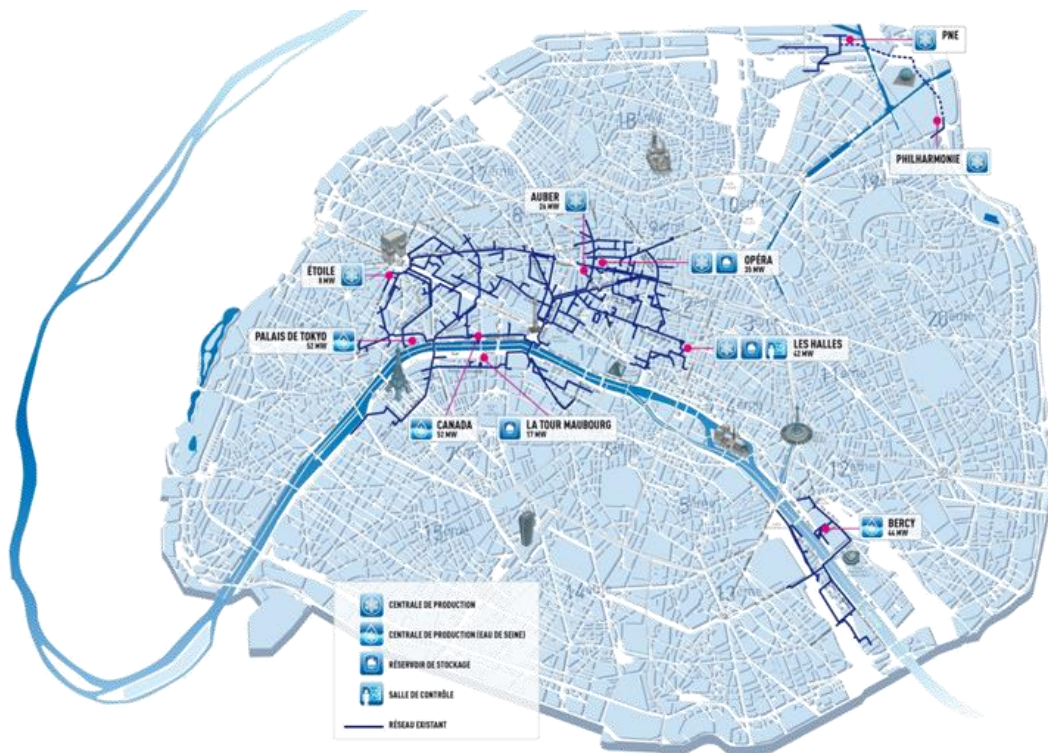


Key figures

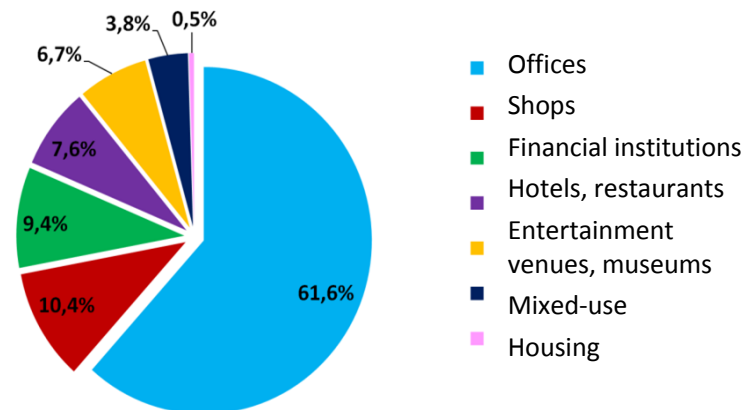
- ➔ 550 connected customers

- ➔ 130 employees

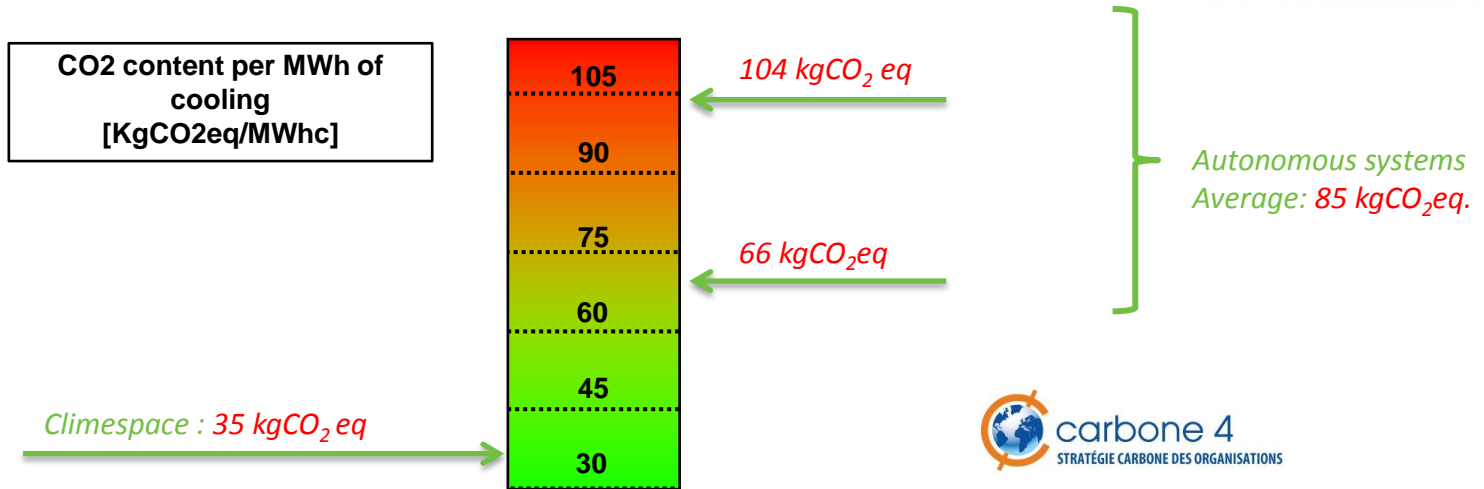

Breakdown of subscribed power per customer type





- 5 million m² of space in Paris is air-conditioned by the district cooling network
- 20,600 tCO₂eq. avoided/year (412 GWh of energy sold in 2012)*
- 0.3 to 0.5% of emissions in Paris's building sector

- In 2013, all of Climespace's production sites were powered by renewable sources, thereby delivering responsible cooling to its customers.
